Intermediate Acrylic Painting Supply List

- Acrylic Paint: Golden Brand is recommended but student grade or store brand paints are fine. Cadmium colors may be substituted for yellow and reds that are close in color if the brand you choose does not have them.
 - Titanium or Permalba White (large tube is preferable)
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Cadmium Yellow Light
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Thalo Green
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Ivory or Mars Black
 - Thalo Red Rose
- Limited Palette Options for those who prefer Color-Mixing:
 - Titanium or Permalba White (large tube)
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Thali Red Rose
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Thalo Green
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Ivory or Mars Black
- Pad of Newsprint 18" x 24" or 24" x 36"
- Two 9" x 12" (or larger) Canvas Panels, Stretched Canvas or Prepared Wood Panel.
- Strathmore 300 Series Palette Paper Pad or the like. *(we will be talking about possible later investment in Materson's "STA-WET Handy Palette Box" [large size] so you might want to eyeball that when you are in the store. It's a nice way to keep the palette you created in class wet for a few days so when you go home you'll be ready to continue working, or have a nice color reference to mix on top of.)*

- Acrylic Retarder
- Fluid Matte Medium
- Bring any other materials that you prefer to work with.
