Advanced Drawing & Painting: Figure Studies

- Two-pack of Prismacolor Ebony Pencils
- One kneaded eraser and one Artgum eraser
- 18" x 24" Newsprint pad
- Three 16" x 20" canvases (please stain them lightly with a green/brown wash)
- Four tubes of acrylic paint (Premier brand @ A.C. Moore is fine):
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Vermillion or Cadmium Red
 - White
 - Yellow Ochre

(You may bring in additional ancillary colors like Cerulean Blue and Viridian as desired for clothing)

- Two acrylic brushes:
 - #1 Round
 - #4 Filbert

(On the "Jerry's Artarama" site there is a TryMe pack of Pro-stroke Powercyl brushes by Creative Mark that contains these two brushes for \$1.25!)

Instructor will provide palettes, and palette paper for the painting segments of the class.

Instructor will provide additional drawing materials such as vine charcoal/chamois cloths, Conte crayon, etc.

Students may bring in additional drawing materials as desired.

Materials may be purchased online at Jerry's Artarama, Dick Blick Art Supplies, etc. or physical stores like A.C. Moore, Michaels, and the Art Emporium on Lyman Street, Westboro. Mention Linda Pierce Classes for a 10% discount.
