## Foundations of Painting: Color

- Acrylic paint heavy body\*:
  - Titanium white 5oz
  - Cadmium yellow light or lemon yellow 2oz
  - Cadmium yellow medium or cadmium yellow deep 2oz
  - Cadmium red light 2oz
  - Alizarin red 2oz
  - Cerulean blue 2oz
  - Ultramarine blue 2oz

Additional colors (not required):

- Viridian 2oz
- Yellow ochre 2oz
- Burnt sienna 2oz

\*I would suggest buying a good quality paint, the tinting properties are much better and coverage is better. Some I recommend Golden, Utrecht, M. Graham, Windsor Newton. Liquitex is ok but not as good.

- Various size brushes: Filberts, Rounds and Flats. Have a small, medium and large selection. I find that filberts are the most versatile.
- Palette knife
- Paper palette (comes in pad) 18" x 24" or a covered palette with sponge insert.
- Paper towels
- 1 piece of watercolor paper 18" x 24"
- Canvas board or canvas paper (come in pad) 18" x 24"
- Small sketch pad
- Drawing pencil/soft
- Kneaded eraser
