HIGH SCHOOL FASHION STUDIES

-18 x 2" clear plastic ruler

-1 ½" or 2" binder (for storing notes and swatch pages) filled w/ loose-leaf paper

-2 Pocket Folder inserts for binder for storing hand-outs

-Clear page-protector binder inserts for storing swatches and/or magazine cut-outs

-Black foam core board 20"x 30"

-9" X 12" pad of tracing paper

-9" x 12" sketchbook

-9" x 12" pad of marker paper (50 pages) Bienfang Graphics 360 Marker Paper ok

-9" x 12" portfolio for storing drawings

-Dual-tip ART MARKERS (Pantone or Prismacolor ok)

2 flesh-tone –one light and one darker (for shading)

3-6 colors of your choice

-2 or more very fine black sharpies or micron pens

-Pencils (mechanical preferred) and eraser (kneaded preferred)

-Pencil case for drawing supplies

-scotch tape/ paper scissors/ glue sticks

-2-3 Magazines to cut up: architecture, interior design, fashion, National Geographic

-Tape measure (dressmakers)

-Fabric scissors
