- 9" x 12" Watercolor paper (140lb)
- Standard 81/x" x 11" printer paper or 9" x 12" newsprint for sketching and warm-up
- 9" x 12" Drawing paper (or larger)
- Willow Charcoal
- Drawing pencils: 2H, 2B and 6B
- Kneaded eraser
- · Pink pearl eraser
- · Sharpie fine and ultra fine point
- Tortillion
- Elmer's glue
- Acrylic paint: Red, Blue, Yellow, Black and White, plus any other colors you would like to work with. Liquitex Primary set of 5 works great.
- Crayons Education Watercolor set 8 colors
- Assorted brushes small and medium round brushes for detail, medium (1/4") and large flat brushes for fill.
- Any collected magazines, mail advertisements, newspaper, tissue paper, wrapping paper or any scrap printed paper around your house.
- Materials suggested for class are: paper plates, recycled containers, paper towels, aluminum foil and things for clean-up, covering and mixing paint.
- Suggested, but not required:
 - Sketchbook that is at least 8" x 10"
 - One metallic acrylic paint (craft paint is fine)
