Intermediate Watercolor Supply List

Paper 140lb cold press watercolor paper (Strathmore 11x15" or larger or watercolor block. It would be great to have a couple of 22x30" sheets of cotton rag paper (Canson, Montval, Arches, Fabriano, or Canson L'Aquarelle

Palette: White plastic palette or "butcher's" tray with a large mixing area is helpful.

Paints: Artists' Watercolor Tubes, Daniel Smith Watercolor Paints, Holbein Artists' Watercolors, Sennelier Watercolors If buying tube colors, I suggest getting a "cool" and a "warm" version of red, blue, and yellow. For example: **Warm:** Cadmium Red, French Ultramarine Blue, Hansa Yellow **Cool:** Quinacridone Red, Phthalocyanine Blue, Quinacridone Gold

Brushes: One or two of these brushes are a good addition to your regular brushes: Haike square brushes 3in 2in, 1in, a large square Mottler brush, oval wash brush, dagger brush, quill brush,

Your choice of paper towels, tissues,

Sketchbook. Get a size that you feel comfortable using. Most of mine are around 5.5 x 8"

Masking liquid. I recommend Pebeo Drawing Gum (old brushes (assorted sizes) for gum only

Blue Artist Tape

Optional Supplies: Sea Sponge, Black or sepia waterproof pen (*Sakura Pigma Micron*),
Easel Pocket knife Palette knife (steel, not plastic)
