

Danforth Assistantship Program

This year-round leadership program for teens provides valuable experience in educational functions at the Danforth Art School and the Danforth Art Museum.

Danforth Assistants serve the art school by helping with overall program facilitation during Summer Arts, our highly popular summer program for children, as well as school vacation week workshops and scheduled events which take place year-round. Assisting at the school includes working directly with children, providing support for teachers, preparation of materials and studio spaces, organization of supplies, and various administrative tasks. Danforth Assistants serve the museum by providing tours of the exhibitions to children during Summer Arts and providing support during public programming such as Drop Into Art and other events.

We typically welcome several Assistants back each year, which allows us to place roughly 15 new leaders every Spring.

Placement in the Danforth Assistantship Program provides many benefits upon successful participation in the program*. These include a modest stipend, one free class during the Fall, Winter or Spring sessions, valuable leadership experience, individualized mentorship and important references for college transcripts.

Danforth accepts applications from responsible, reliable, and energetic teens currently enrolled in or entering high school or college. Successful participation is considered to be:

- Attendance at a **mandatory** four-session training course taking place on Saturdays during the spring, which will provide the necessary training for summer programming and service in the museum
- Completing at least four weeks of service during Summer Arts
- Serving at three public events at the Danforth over the following year as well as 2 days during School Vacation Weeks in February or April
- Submitting an agreement which outlines understanding of expectations and a commitment to work on agreed upon dates

Weeks of service in Summer Arts do not need to be consecutive, but they must be full weeks, with all full days from 8:15 A.M.-4:15 P.M. Public events take place on weekends.

Danforth Assistantship Training Course

Acceptance to the Danforth Assistantship is contingent upon attendance in the no-cost, training course which will be held at the School on Saturdays on the following dates:

May 3 12-3 pm

May 10 12-3 pm

May 17 12-3 pm

May 31 12-4pm

It is crucial that applicants attend all of these training dates in order to be prepared for a successful experience and to fulfill the obligations of the position. If there is a date which is an immovable conflict, please contact Kathy DeAntonio, Summer Arts Manager to discuss.

Applications are accepted until **March 28, 2025**. All selected applicants will require an interview.
