Foundations of Acrylic Painting with Lee Ball - Supply List

Welcome! Here is a list of basic materials for our class. I prefer Liquitex basic paint for learning, but I use Golden Open acrylics in my professional work. I will use Liquitex basics in class, but will help with other brands if you choose them. Generic paints have more fillers and less pigment and will not mix color well.

Liquitex basics colors we will use:

Ultramarine **Cerulean Blue** Lemon Yellow Cadmium Yellow Medium hue Quinacridone Magenta Cadmium Red Medium hue Burnt Sienna Yellow Ocher Titanium White *Supplemental Colors you may want at some point, but are NOT required: Burnt Umber, Alizarin Crimson, Phthalo Blue (green shade), Palette – I will use paper palette pad Round Brushes - small, medium, large Flat brushes $-\frac{1}{2}$ " (my favorite brushes are flats, you may want a couple of the $\frac{1}{2}$ " flats) 4H or HB graphite pencil and eraser Canvas paper pad, canvas board, or stretched canvas at least 8"x 8" or larger (I use 9x12 or square sizes most)

Painters blue tape

Paper towels and/or wet wipes

Paper for sketching and testing ideas - could be a notebook

Things I will bring in and you may want later:

Acrylic Gesso

Acrylic mediums: gloss, satin, matte, heavy gel

Open Acrylic (just for testing)

Exploratory things – Prismacolor pencil, Tomboy brush pen, Sharpies,
